**Constitutional Convention** 

- I. After Shays's Rebellion people realized gov. needed change
  - A. Constitutional Convention to rewrite Articles
- II. Representation
  - A. How many reps would each state get?
    - 1. Large States=Virginia Plan
      - a. Representation based on population
      - b. Lg states need more reps because they represent more people
    - 2. Small states=New Jersey Plan
      - a. Equal number of representatives
      - b. Small states would be outvoted if larger states had all the reps.
  - B. Great Compromise
    - 1. Divided legislature into 2 parts
      - a. Senate- equal number per state
      - b. House of Representatives- # based on population.
      - c. Laws need approval by both to pass.
- IIi. Slaves as part of population
  - A. Important point because population determines
    - 1. Representation
    - 2. Taxes
  - B. Northern states= No slaves
    - 1. Slaves cannot vote, shouldn't be counted for representation
    - 2. Slaves are property, should be counted for taxes.
  - C. Southern states=slaves
    - 1. Slaves should count for population in determining representation
      - a. need more reps in House to balance Senate.
      - b. Slave not have rights nor representation
    - 2. Slaves should not count for taxes.
  - D. 3/5 Compromise
    - 1. 3/5 of slave population counts for representation & taxes.
- IV. Slave trade
  - A. Northerners
    - 1. Congress should regulate trade
    - 2. Slaves who run away to free territory should be free
  - B. Southerners

- 1. Congress should not regulate trade- feared ending the slave trade
- 2. Slaves are property and should be returned if they run away
- C. Commerce Compromise- Great "No" Compromise
  - 1. Slave trade allowed to continue for 20 years unregulated.
  - 2. Run-aways must be returned.
