Directions for Territories Map

Use a black felt tip pen to trace your outlines, rivers, trails and mountain ranges. If you are absent you will need to make arrangements with me to come in during lunch.

Part I- Base Map: Neatly draw in, label and color the following:

- Appalachians, Rockies and the Cascade Mountains. p. RA4
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- 2. Mississippi & Rio Grand rivers. p. RA6,7
- 3. Atlantic Ocean, Gulf of Mexico. p. RA5
- 4. Canada, Mexico and the United States in 1787 p. RA6

Part II- Territories

1. Using the tracing paper, trace each of the territories from the master copy. To make this map look the best, make sure the tracing paper completely covers the outline of the United States. **Trace only the territory**. Pay attention to the maps that have 2 territories on it. Trace both territories on one piece of tracing paper.

Color each territory a different color. See the example.

2. In the center of each territory, write its name, how we obtained it and the date we added it to the U.S.

Part III- cover (optional)

Make a cover for map titled "U.S. Expansion". Don't forget to write your name.

Once you have all the territories outlined, staple them together so that everything lines up neatly. Make sure you put them in date order with the first territory on the bottom, the last territory on top.
